

















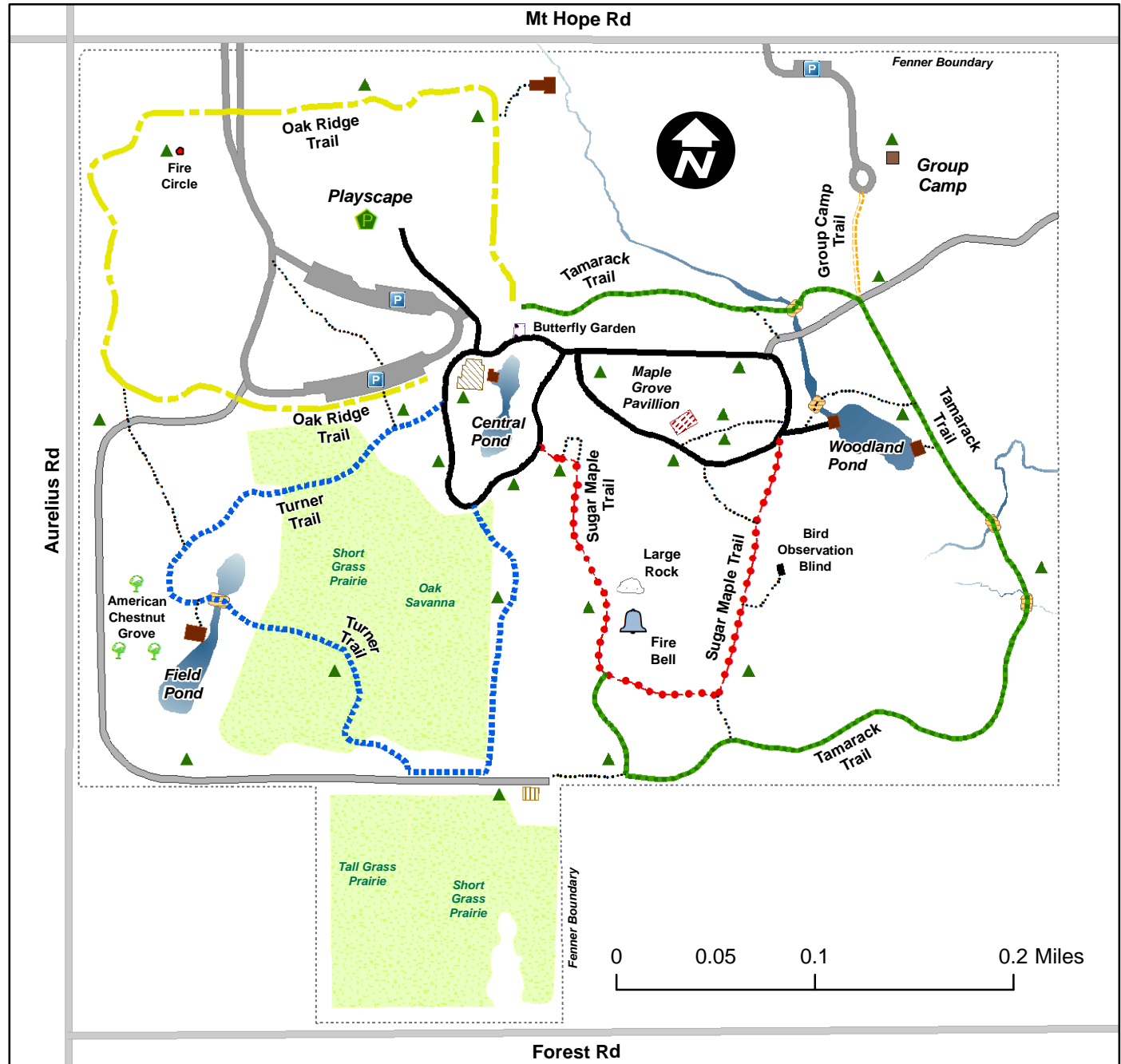


Fenner Nature Center Trail Guide
